

CLOSING POP-UP BLOCKERS FOR www.assessmentstation.com

MAC Users

Mac browsers such as Safari and Mozilla Firefox have pop-up blockers built in that must be turned off. Some newer Mac computers have the ability to open in a Windows environment and use Windows-based browsers (such as Internet Explorer). Please note - there may be multiple pop-up blockers installed either in the browser tool-bar or add-ons which were included with programs that have been installed. Often these additional pop-up blockers are ignored – **please remember to turn these off as well.**

The Prevue Assessment opens in a pop-up window and pop-ups must be allowed in the browser to gain access to the assessment -- in other words, ALL pop-up blockers MUST be disabled to allow the Prevue Assessment to function.

If pop-up blockers are not disabled, the candidate will receive a message that the assessment is open in another window, although this is untrue.

There are three ways to deactivate blockers to allow pop-ups on the Prevue Assessment's website:


1. Completely turn off the pop-up blocker.
2. You can also add the Prevue Assessment website to an "allow list". This will allow pop-ups for the Prevue Assessment's website only, while blocking pop-ups for all other sites. **RECOMMENDED**
3. Press and hold the CTRL key while clicking a link that opens a pop-up on the Prevue Assessment's website. This will override Pop-Up Blocker just for that one click and allow any pop-up windows resulting from the click to appear. You will have to hold down the CTRL key before clicking the link every time you click on a link that is currently being blocked.



Turning off the Pop-Up Blocker from the Safari Browser Tool Bar








Safari will now allow you to click "ENTER" to access the Prevue Assessment.




Turning off the Pop-Up Blocker from the Firefox Browser Tool Bar




Firefox will display this message when you click on "Preferences."




Clicking here will unblock ALL pop-ups.


Clicking here allows you to unblock the website that is currently activated. (RECOMMENDED)
